Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made in writing and received in the Beaufort County Board of Elections office by 5:00 PM on Tuesday, October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2015. Absentee voting begins on October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015 and ends at 5:00 PM on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015. The Board of Elections will meet on October 13<sup>th</sup> (5:00 pm), October 20<sup>th</sup> (5:00 pm), October 27<sup>th</sup> (5:00 pm), and November 2<sup>nd</sup> (5:00 pm) for the purpose of approving absentee ballot applications. One-stop absentee voting will be held in the board of elections office, 1308 Highland Drive, Suite 104, Washington, NC beginning October 22<sup>nd</sup> and ending Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup> at 1:00 pm. One-stop voting hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup>, is the only Saturday the Office will be open during the One Stop period and will be closing at 1:00 pm. Canvass Day will be held at 11:00 am in the Beaufort County Board of Elections Office in Washington, NC on November 10<sup>h</sup>, 2015.

All residents of the City of Washington who are registered to vote with the Beaufort County Board of Elections may vote in this election. Voters who are previously registered need not re-register for this election. Those residents of the City of Washington who are not registered to vote must register on or before Friday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2015 in order to be eligible to vote in this election. Alternatively you may register and, if eligible then vote at the Board of Elections one-stop site. Any voter who has moved outside his or her precinct but within the county since the last election should notify the Board of Elections in writing by October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2015.
