

Notice of Primary Election
Beaufort County, North Carolina

A Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, May 6th, 2014, in Beaufort County, North Carolina to vote on the offices of: US Senate (Republican, Democratic, Libertarian), US House of Representatives District 1 (Republican, Democratic), US House District 3 (Republican), NC State Senate District 1 (Democratic), NC House District 6 (Republican), Sheriff (Republican, Democratic), County Commissioner (Republican), and NC Supreme Court Associate Justice. Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m.

Voter registration will close at 5 pm on Friday, April 11, 2014. Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made in writing on the form provided and approved by the NC State Board of Elections. Hand-written requests are no longer acceptable for absentee ballot requests. The request must be received in the Beaufort County Board of Elections by 5 pm on Tuesday, April 29th, 2014. Absentee voting by mail begins on March 17th and ends at 5 pm on Tuesday May 6th, 2014. Absentee ballots that are hand delivered must be received in the Beaufort County Board of Elections Office by 5 pm on Tuesday May, 6th, 2014. Absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by Tuesday, May 6th, 2014 and received no later than Friday, May 9th at 5pm.
